6. PROCEEDING OF THE TRUST

- A. The Trustees shall hold such meetings as may from time to time be necessary for considering any matter connected with the Trust or its affairs or to transact any business of the Trust and may be held at such places as the Managing Trustee may decide. The meeting of the Trustees shall be held at least once in three months. Three Trustees present shall form a quorum for the meeting, one of them be the first Trustee.
- B. In the absence of the Chairman at any meeting, the Trustees who may be present at the meeting may nominate a Chairman for the meeting as prescribed by the rules.
- C. The proceedings of the Trust meetings shall be kept record in a minute book. The Managing Trustee / Settlor of the Trust shall have the custody of all deeds and documents of title relating to Trust properties and investments and books of accounts and other records relating to the Trust and shall be responsible for the same.
- D. In case of difference of opinion arising among the Trustees and the votes are equally divided, the Chairman shall have casting vote, which shall be final and binding on the other Trustees.

7. BANK ACCOUNT

All income, subscription and pecuniary for the general purposes of the Trust and the income, investments and all other money from time to time forming part of the general revenue of the Trust shall on the same being

- ix. To enter into any contracts on behalf of the Trust.
- x. To borrow any money upon the scrutiny of any of the property of the Trust and to grant mortgages for securing the same without any security and upon such terms and conditions the Trustees may deem fit.
- xi. To make and from time to time repeal and / or alter regulations;
 - a) As to the management of the Trust and the affairs thereof.
 - b) As to the duties and remuneration of any officer or servants of the Trust.
 - c) As to the conduct or any of the matter or things within the powers or under the control of the Trustees provided that the same shall not be inconsistent with the provisions contained in these presents.
- xii. To settle out of court, compromise or compound all suits, actions and other proceedings and all differences and demands and to refer all or any such differences and demand to arbitration and to execute releases and to settle and approve all accounts without being answerable for any loss occasioned thereby.
- xiii. To create an advisory board having members not less than two to counsel the Trustees.
- xiv. To appoint and dismiss Managers, Secretaries, Treasurers, Clerks and other staff and workers required for working of its business or industry and other staff and workers required for working of its business or industry and for general management of the affairs of the Trust.
- xv. To make changes in the object of the Trust which are consistent with the attainment of the main object.

17. To promote, organize, administer, establish support, maintain and /or grant to any person, institution or society or organization whatsoever having for its objects or charitable purposes and to incur expenditure in connection therewith.
18. To promote, assist and / or maintain all activities by whosoever carried on or wherever carried on in India in conformity with the objects of the Trust and as are conducive to the well being and general welfare of the nation prepare conducive for advancement of any object or objects of general public utility not involving / carrying on any activity for profit, etc.
19. To publish and / or publishing books, yearly magazine, pamphlets, periodicals, newspapers through print and electronic media and / or objects in India or outside for the spread and advancement of culture, social, spiritual, moral and educational values.
20. To give, provide and / or render help and assistance to and or implement any scheme for providing livelihood and upliftment of the poor.
21. To establish and conduct institutions, moral / spiritual educational and Dhamma study centre's, Buddhist Viharas, Meditation Centres, meetings to propagate buddhism.
22. To do or undertake any or all acts of charitable incidental or necessary to the attainment to the above object or objects.

4. TRUSTEES

- A. The number of the Trustees shall at no time be less than two or more than seven together called Board of Trustees. Four more seats are reserved to allocate as and when suitable persons are available. Initially the following shall be the first Trustees consisting of three members.
- B. The vacancy created by the resignation or removal of the Trustees, may be filled with the unanimous choice of remaining Trustees. In the case of the managing Trustee or Chairman or Settlor or Author of the Trust, the vacancy will be filled from the Trustees for the time being.
- C. The first Trustees may appoint from time to time and may co-opt any person with outstanding qualities with reference to the Trust objects and other by laws or regulations appointed to be the other Trustees whose tenure of office shall not be more than two years at a time.
- D. The Settlor / Author / Chairman all in all of the Board of Trust and Trustees shall preside over all the meetings of the Trust.

5. POWER OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

- A. The Trustees shall have all the powers necessary or incidental for effective carrying out the objects of the Trust.
- B. The Board of Trustees is hereby authorized to and it may from time to time, make and prescribe additional objects of the Trust by Resolution passed by the Chairman and at least one member from the Board of Trustees. If at any time the objects of the Trust should become impossible

5. To give, provide and / or render food, medicine and other help including marriage expense assistance for poor and / or assistance in any shape of form to the poor deserving and needy persons.
6. To give, provide and / or render monetary and / or other help and assistance for the relief of persons and animals effected by natural and other calamities such as flood, fire, famine, cyclone, earthquake, storm, accident, pestilence, drought, epidemic, unbearable cost of living and the like, to give donations, subscriptions or contribution to institutions, establishments, centers or persons doing relief work on such occasions.
7. To give, provide, distribute dhotis (Under cloth), Blankets, Rugs, Woolen cloths, Quilt of cotton, Woolen, Silk or other varieties of cloths or other articles of necessity and facilities for the poor.
8. To open, found, establish, promote, set-up, run, maintain, assist, finance, support and / or help in the setting up and / or running School, College, University, Clinic, Hospital, Lecture halls and other establishments or institutions for advancement of education and of knowledge in arts, science, literature, boarding houses, libraries, reading-rooms, gymnasium, humanities and all other useful subjects in all their manifestations and other training and vocational institutes and etc.
9. To foster and encourage meditation and education and training, in handicrafts, fine arts, among women fold in general and establish and found institutions imparting, such education and to establish, maintain,

NOW THIS DEED OF DECLARATION OF TRUST WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

1. NAME

The name of the Trust shall be **“GIRIMĀNANDA DHAMMĀ SĀSANA TRUST”**

2. REGISTERED OFFICE

The principal office of the Trust shall be situated at Chichingherra, Manughat, Dhalai Tripura-799275, India or such other places as the Trustees may from time to time decide. The decision of the majority is final.

3. OBJECTS

1. To establish and maintain Meditation Centre, Libraries and meditation hall and reading room and meditation cottages (Kuties) and religious research institute for the welfare of meditation members of the whole and various societies.
2. To establish, promote, set-up, maintain, assist, mental support, finance support /or and aid to or help in the setting and/ or maintaining and/ or running schools and college and university and other institutions as studies centre, widow houses, lunatic asylums, poor houses or other establishments for relief and/ or help to the poor, old and infirm people and / or destitute.
3. To give, provide and/ or render help and assistance in cash or kind to poor and/ or destitute people, widows, etc.

2. **Sri. Skiro Chakma**, S/O: Nabin Chandra Chakma, Pabia cherra, Sukanta Nagar, Unakoti Tripura, Pin: 799264.

WHEREAS the above said **SETTLOR (AUTHOR) OF THE TRUST** decided to create and establish for the welfare of the community at large, with objects and contribution as hereunder set forth and with service minded Trustees.

WHEREAS the above named Trust will function according to sections 2(15), 11, 12, 13, and 80-G of Income Tax Act, 1961, without any discrimination of caste, genders, creeds, religions etc, for the welfare of community and without the intention of profits.

WHEREAS the said object in view, the **SETTLOR (AUTHOR) OF THE TRUST** have decided to endow the said **TRUST** a nucleus of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees- Ten Thousand) only in cash, and by delivering the said amount in cash which the party of the other part, the Trustees have accepted and also determines that hereafter all receipts of voluntary contributions and other similar income should be used only for the objects of this Trust.

For matters provided for in these presents, the provisions of the Indian Trust Act and the income Tax Act, 1961 and rules made there-under will apply accordingly.

received be paid into a banking account with any scheduled bank for the purpose of the Trust. The bank accounts shall be operated by the **Settlor/ Author of the Trust / Managing Trustee** along with any one of the remaining Trustees as per the decision of the Board of Trustees.

8. ACCOUNT AND AUDIT

- A. The Trustees shall keep proper books of account of all the assets liabilities and income and expenditure of the Trust and shall prepare an Income and expenditure Account and Balance Sheet for every year on the last day of June.
- B. The account of every year shall be audited by a Chartered Accountant who shall be appointed for that purpose by the Trustees and the audited accounts shall be placed at a meeting of the Trustees, which shall be held before the end of the succeeding year.

9. IRREVOCABLE

This Trust is irrevocable.

10. ACTIVITIES OF THE TRUST

The activities of the Trust shall be in India and its union territories (whole India) and shall be extended anywhere outside of India.

11. WINDING UP

In the event of dissolution or winding up of the Trust, the assets remaining as on the date of dissolution shall under no circumstances be

of fulfillment, the properties and funds belonging to the Trust shall be utilized for such other allied purposes as the Board of Trustees may determine.

C. Subject to the general provisions of the Trust and without prejudice to the general and specified powers conferred upon the Trustees by the other provisions contained in these presents, the Trustees shall have the following powers also.

- i. To apply the Trust money to effectuate one object or some of the objects of the Trust in preference to the other objects.
- ii. To discontinue the application of Trust Fund to the object and divert the funds to another object.
- iii. To decide the nature and functions of the institutions to be established by the Trust and to decide whether and if so what existing institution or institutions may be taken over by the Trust or to which any aid may be given.
- iv. In case it is decided to render financial or other aid to any person or institution to decide what terms and conditions should be compiled by such person or institution.
- v. To determinate the terms and conditions on which any donations subscriptions, scholarships or prizes are to be given by the Trust.
- vi. To expend the funds of the Trust in such manner as they shall consider most beneficial for the purpose of the Trust.
- vii. To acquire, build upon, pull down, rebuild, add to, repair, improve, sell or dispose of any land, building or premises for the use of the Trust and to dispose of the same.
- viii. To acquire any property in exchange for some other property or partly in such exchange and partly for other consideration.
